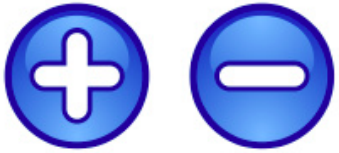

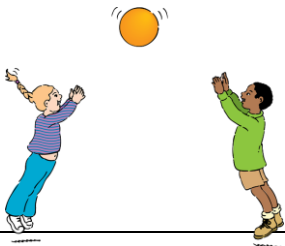

The children will continue to practice the formation of capital letters and consider the sizing's over lower case letters. Children will also learn about contracted forms. Reading and phonics will continue through RWI and the children will prepare for the Phonics Screening Check. 	<u>SCIENCE</u> To explore plants by preparing a planter and planting and maintaining seeds and bulbs.
