English

The children will explore the 'Three Little Pigs' story and innovate it with new characters. They will write a recount of the farm trip.

Children will compile all they have learnt about farms into a report.

The children learn how to read and write plurals by adding 's' and 'es,' and using the suffixes (with no change to the root word) 'ing', 'ed', 'er', 'est'. They learn about compound words and contracted forms.

They recap handwriting families, ascenders and descenders.


