MATHEMATICS

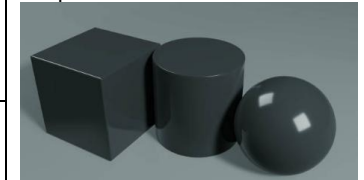
To count, read, write numerals 100 and understand place value to 100. Counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.
